



## SCHOOL UNIFORM DETAILS - WAVELL DRESS CODE

Wavell State High School students are required to maintain the highest standard of dress and grooming. Students' hair is to be neat, tidy and appropriate for school at all times. Extreme or inappropriate hair styles for school will not be tolerated.

Formal dress uniform is to be worn to and from school on all days except the designated sport day which is held each Wednesday for Years 9 and 10 and those students in Years 11 and 12 who select sport. Year 8 sports day varies according to Form Class - students will be advised on timetables issued on the first day of the year.

Students are permitted to wear their sports uniform on the designated sports day to, from and during school. On **all** other days when practical classes demand a specialist uniform eg. Health and Physical Education, Dance, Drama - students will change before class into their required dress, and following the specialist lesson will change back into the dress uniform.

School uniform should be worn only at school or when travelling to or from school activities. Students should change out of school uniform upon arrival home. They should not wear parts of the uniform with casual clothing at other times.

Girls may wear one pair of studs or sleepers and one small signet ring. Boys are not permitted to wear jewellery. A watch is not considered to be a piece of jewellery. No other jewellery is permitted for boys or girls.

Boys are expected to be clean shaven.

**All Uniform requirements with the exception of shoes are available from the school Clothing Shop. Bankcard, Mastercard, Visacard and Lay-bys are accepted.**

### DRESS UNIFORM - GIRLS

HAT:	Dress Panama (optional but recommended)
HAIR RIBBON:	Maroon, royal blue, white
BLAZER:	Maroon with School Crest on pocket (optional)
JUMPER:	Maroon, long-sleeved "V" neck
JACKET: (CLUB)	Maroon with navy and white bands on cuff and neck, zip front.
TIE:	Senior-(Yrs 11/12), Maroon with embroidered School Crest. (Prefects wear a navy tie) Junior-(Yrs 8, 9, 10), Maroon with junior navy and white diagonal stripe.
BLOUSE:	White peplum blouse banded at the waist - 7.5 cm waistband cut on the cross to fit around the hips, sleeves with cuff.
SKIRT:	Junior navy-central box pleat 10 cm, two 4 cm knife pleats on either side, back and front. Skirt to be no more than 5 cm from floor in kneeling position.
SOCKS:	Short Red Robin plain white socks 'turnabout'.
STOCKINGS:	Black coloured two-way stretch nylon pantyhose (optional).

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SHOES: Black leather college lace-up shoes.

\* For safety reasons shoes with leather uppers must be worn in Science, Home Economics and Manual Arts classes.

## DRESS UNIFORM - BOYS

HAT Maroon Cap (optional but recommended)

BLAZER: Maroon with School Crest on pocket. (optional)

JUMPER: Maroon, long-sleeved "V" neck.

JACKET (CLUB): Maroon with navy and white bands on cuff and neck, zip front.

TIE: Senior - (Years 11/12), Maroon with embroidered School Crest.  
(Prefects wear a navy tie).

SHIRT: White, (two way collar), short sleeves or long sleeves, with School Badge on pocket if not wearing a tie. Pocket badge is available at the school clothing shop.

TROUSERS: Long dark college grey with grey socks or dark college grey dress shorts with long grey School socks.

SOCKS: Short - dark college grey; Long - grey Wavell socks with bands in school colours (available only from the Clothing Shop).

SHOES: Black leather college lace-up shoes.

\* For safety reasons shoes with leather uppers must be worn in Science, Home Economics and Manual Arts classes.

\* Students taking Manual Arts and Home Economics are to wear an apron to protect clothing. Aprons are sold at the Clothing Shop.

## SPORTS UNIFORM - GIRLS

SPORTS SKIRT: Royal Blue 'Hockey' Skirt.  
Front: Two inverted pleats on either side of centre 20 cm apart. Pocket on inside of waist band.  
Back: Two inverted pleats on either side of centre 20 cm apart. Elastic in waist band.  
(Sports skirt to be no more than 15 cm from ground in kneeling position).

SPORTS SHIRT: Maroon polo shirt with white collar which has two royal blue stripes. School crest on left side.

SPORTS SHORTS: Royal Blue stretchknit with draw cord and "W" on leg.

UNDERGARMENT: Blue sportsnick or royal blue bike pants with white and maroon stripe on left leg.

SHOES: White sports shoes. **Expensive brands of sports shoes are not recommended or required. High ankle (basketball boot style) are not permitted.**

SOCKS: As for Formal Uniform.

SWIMMING COSTUME: One piece.

STOCKINGS: Flesh-coloured may be worn on cool days.

HAT: Maroon cap embroidered with white 'W'. (optional but recommended)

## SPORTS UNIFORM - BOYS

- T-SHIRT: Maroon polo shirt with white collar which has two royal blue stripes. School crest on left side.
- SHORTS: Royal Blue Stubbies made of polyester/viscose as sold in Uniform Shop.
- SHOES: White sports shoes. **Expensive brands of sports shoes are not recommended or required. High ankle (basketball boot style) are not permitted.**
- SOCKS: Wavell Sports Socks (available only from the Clothing Shop).
- SWIMMING COSTUME: Boys Trunks.
- HAT: Maroon cap embroidered with white 'W'. (optional but recommended)

**ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING should be CLEARLY MARKED with student name and form class.**

**NOTE:**

1. **There is no provision for a tracksuit.** In very cold weather, students should wear dress uniform and change into sports uniform for the two sports lessons. Girls may wear black coloured stockings with dress uniform or flesh coloured stockings with sports uniform.
2. Girls are to wear either socks or stockings, not both.
3. ALL accessories (Jackets, Pullovers, etc) must be maroon in colour.
4. BLAZERS - a quantity of blazers in various sizes is kept in stock.
