EXPECTATIONS

- All students must meet the Behaviour and attendance criteria outlined in the Behaviour Management Process.
- Students will be expected to attend school regularly and to work diligently in all their school subjects.
- Students will be expected to follow the School of Excellence Behaviour Management process to remain enrolled in the course.

School of Excellence – Rugby League will be studied during normal class time allocated for subjects, as well as during additional hours in the gym and on the training field. A high degree of commitment to this course is essential and students must be prepared to sacrifice their own time for training, gym work and games, both before and after school, as well as in the evenings.

At the start of 2017 all families will be expected to sell a book of raffle tickets per student. This raffle helps us to avoid a significant raise in the student levies. Students will receive their socks and shorts for free once the tickets are sold. The APPROXIMATE Rugby League levy for each student in the School of Excellence is located below. This will assist in providing specialist tutors, strapping, camps, training and playing apparel and guest speakers for workshops. Other costs, such as transport to playing venues may need to be met by students.
