Eligibility & Selection Criteria

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must:

2. Prioritise school commitments, agreeing; within parameters determined by the Executive Principal to participate in Wavell activities before outside engagements.
3. Exhibit leadership qualities, serving as positive role models, supporting peers, and contributing to a strong sense of school spirit.
4. Along with parents or caregivers, actively support the values and expectations of Wavell State High School both within and outside the school environment.
5. Show appreciation for school life and a willingness to participate in the wide range of opportunities Wavell offers.
6. Be committed to the School's Vision: "Empowering Learners. Empowering Futures."
