INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants are required to perform two pieces (or excerpts) that show contrast, diversity and demonstrate their skill. Total performance length should be no more than 10 minutes.
Percussion students need to perform on both tuned and un-tuned percussion.
2. Applicants will be required to complete sight-reading and technical work suitable to their level.
3. Applicants will be expected to answer questions about their musical experiences, aspirations and how they intend to contribute to the musical life of the school.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Interested applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Perform on a Brass, Woodwind, Percussion, String Instrument or Bass Guitar
- Be enrolled at Wavell State High School in Years 7 -12
- Demonstrate high academic standards
- Be willing to have a strong involvement in Instrumental Music lessons and ensembles.
- Demonstrate a high level of overall musicianship.
- Display a willingness to learn.

Please note that the school will have the right to review the progress of the scholarship recipient as it deems necessary.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Successful applicants will receive the following for 2022:

- Entry into Wavell State High School (if not already enrolled)
- Entry into the Instrumental Music Program (if not already enrolled)
- Entry into the Music Extension classes, if desired (from Years 7- 12)
- Solo performance opportunities through a variety of Chamber and Excellence Concerts throughout the year that showcase Gifted and Talented students.
- \$500 credit that can be used in full or part thereof the following:
 - ▶ Private tuition on the instrument they successfully auditioned on (private teachers need to be fully accredited)
 - ▶ Instrumental Music Levies and/or Instrument Hire
 - ▶ Other associated music costs ie. Music Tours/Camps/Excursions, Texts, Consumables
